Invenergy has completed development on 12 sustainable energy projects in Arizona and is pursuing additional opportunities in the state.



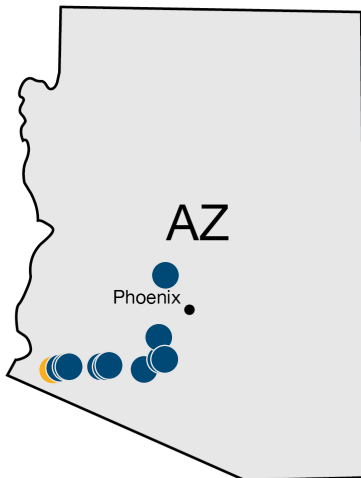
